The Applicant has provided the Inspectorate with spatial data for the purpose of facilitating the identification of consultation bodies to inform a Scoping Opinion (as set out in our Advice Note 7, available on our website). Requests by consultation bodies

to obtain and/or use the spatial data for other purposes should be made directly to the Applicant using the contact details below.
